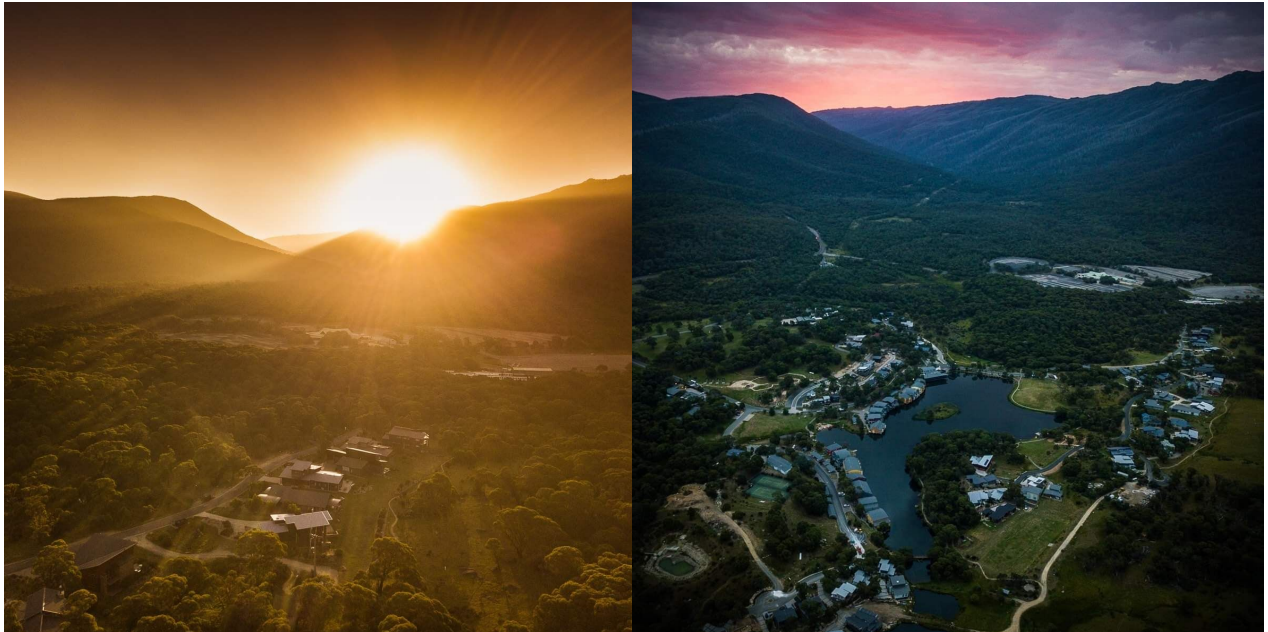

Introduction to The Snowy Mountains:

I travel down to The Snowy Mountains religiously each year for the ski season. The air is crisp, Jindabyne is alive and the snow capped mountains are ready to be carved up by your freshly waxed board!

Last year I had the pleasure of heading down to The Snowy Mountains in the Summer for the very first time and I was blown away at how green and alive the landscape looked - I didn't recognise it. I'm used to seeing icicles hanging off trees, patches of snow, and the side of the road being all wet and muddy.

There are a number of accommodation options to choose from, but Lake Crackenback Resort and Spa is in a class of its own. Whether you choose to stay in your own massive

However long you choose to stay, no matter what time of year, there is always something to do. 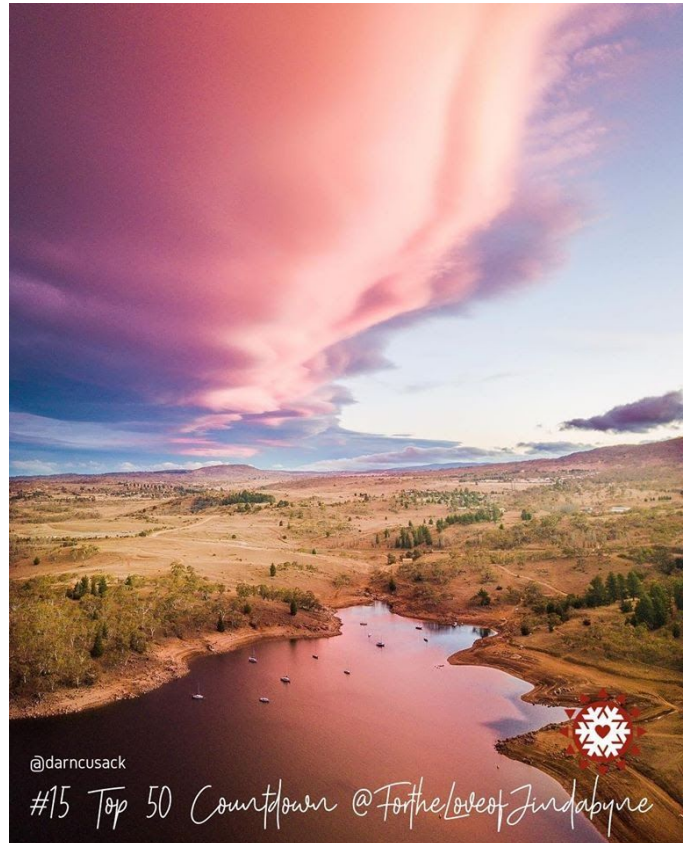
